

Open Eyes

Religion must apply in the moment, and it must deal with death, must be sufficient to be greater than death—far greater. It must be Light, rather than darkness—and it must be so now.

The fundamental heart-impulse is the impulse to Immense Peace—Immense, Objectless, Joyful Peace, Infinitely Conscious....

Every being is moved to This Immense Peacefulness, This Real Happiness, and moves toward It—readily, spontaneously, every day—in the motion towards sleep, the relinquishment that is sleep. Sleep is not unconscious—it is simply objectless.

Light Is Unspeakable.


Be Full of That.
